- Grant Application by Park Avenue Antiques for new Awning. Two phase project, first phase being completed this fall. Sent to board for approval.
- Discussion on old trash receptacle on the corner of Military and Main in front of Dr. Jack's. Recommended to send to board for approval to purchase a new trash receptacle for that location. \$1,000.00
- Discussion on use of Eber's money. Gordon made suggestion on placement of a Historic marker downtown with a brief history of John C Fremont for it. Possible locations discussed were in front of the Courthouse, or across the street in the parking lot at 5th & Park. Also discussed the removal of the broken planters and replacing with the historic marker in one and possibly a bench/rock garden to match the space across the street in the KHUB parking lot. Sheryl/Gordon will do further research with the City regarding this as well as exploring the possibility with Sheri Ebers.
- Seasonal Banners were discussed and agreed to order winter ones for this holiday season. Sheryl will facilitate this/design & bids. \$1,000 was budgeted.
- Agreed on Courthouse as location for placement for 3rd Kiosk. Chris Bristol will do the map and historic piece on the courthouse ready. Sheryl will work with Street Department on placement when finished.
- Other potential projects/ideas discussed: Decorative headers for the Street Signs downtown. Sculpture project downtown, joint venture possibly with the Fremont Art Association. Future Arts Festival organized by the Art Association. Building improvement project. Asking City officials about completion of the Street Scape project and Historic Lighting project.
